About the Mines:

- Bonne Terre mine is located one hour south of St. Louis, in the town of Bonne Terre Missouri
- The mine is illuminated with over 500,000 Watts of lighting from above the water
Visibility is always 100 feet plus
- Water temperature is 60° with no thermo-clines
- There are many dive tours in the mine and you dive them all sequentially
The average length of the dive is 35 to 45 minutes
- Average depth 40 to 60 feet
- Open water certification is all that is necessary to dive the mine
