



DIVE THE ORISKANY IN PENSACOLA FLORIDA

Many exciting artificial reefs have been added to the area's abundant natural ledges and historical wrecks. Here, divers have the choice of visiting sunken battleships, a Russian freighter, fighter planes, oil rigs, Army tanks and more. All are active fish havens that have attracted grouper, snapper, barracuda, flounder, amberjack, and brilliant multi-colored tropicals by the thousands.

Calm seas are common during the months of April through October. Water temperatures stay around 80 degrees. Underwater visibility averages 60 feet, with days of 100-foot visibility common. Grouper, snapper, amberjack, and large grouper are the most plentiful game fish. Larger fish tend to move into the area during the winter. Underwater photography, tropical fish and shell collecting are good at all dive locations; and, of course, the wreck diver will be in paradise.
