About the Mines:

The mine is illuminated with over 500,000 Watts of lighting from above the water

Visibility is always 100 feet plus

Water temperature is 60° with no thermo-clines There are many dive tours in the mine and you dive them all sequentially

The average length of the dive is 35 to 45 minutes Average depth 40 to 60 feet

Open water certification is all that is necessary to dive the mine
